LADOT EXPANDS REAL TIME INFORMATION FOR 14 ADDITIONAL DASH ROUTES

LOS ANGELES (October 2, 2012) — The City of Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) announced the expansion of real time information for 14 more DASH routes effective October 1, 2012. Riders can get information about next bus arrival time by smart phone, web browser, text, or phone.

“LADOT is committed to making it easier to ride our buses,” said LADOT General Manager Jaime de la Vega.

Riders can check the status of a total 19 DASH routes in one of three ways:

1. On-line at www.ladotbus.com, or
2. Text “ladot” and the bus stop number (located on the sign) to 41411
3. Automated telephone line at 213-785-3858

Real time information has been available on 5 DASH Downtown routes for two past two years and will be expanded citywide in the coming months. The system also enables LADOT managers to monitor on-time performance and make service changes to improve service reliability.
